Council Reports

Special Meeting St. John's Church August 4, 2024 Voting for Pastoral Candidate

Dave Swift called the meeting to order after the church service and Pastor Barry opened with prayer.

Dave verified that there were enough members present to take a vote.

Elmer made a motion and seconded by Glen Schaefer to call Bjorn Bakke to be St. John's pastor. While Brian, Dawn and Celine handed out the voting slips, the meeting was open for discussion.

Dave explained that the salary would be \$80,000/year along with 3 weeks of vacation. There was a question asked about social security – The Pastor would pay his portion and the Church would pay their portion which would add to the \$80,000 amount. Weekly giving should be about the same as this salary was figured in when the budget was made in January when we were looking at another candidate. Another question was asked regarding his start date – if a yes vote, he would start August 25th.

Votes were counted with a unanimous 56 yes votes and 0 no votes!

Dave then explained the council's proposed Pastor Covenant Agreement Terms. Along with the salary of \$80,000 and 3 weeks of vacation, he would be reimbursed for mileage at the federal rate for church business. This would either be from church or home, whichever is less. Also proposed was an additional \$10,000 from the general fund with matching funds from the Women's Guild for a total of \$20,000 to go towards either rental space for an office or an addition/remodel at his house for office space.

A motion was made by Gene Konerza and seconded by Marcie Baysinger to accept the Pastor Covenant Agreement as given. The motioned passed with a voice vote without any nays heard.

Dave will get the contract signed today before he heads out of town.

Dave thanked the search committee for their tireless work on sorting through candidates and bringing the best matches to us. He also thanked Pastor Barry for all his time and dedication to our Church these past few years.

Dave reminded the congregation that the Heatwole service is next Sunday, August 11th @ 9:30. He also told us that Pastor Barry's last Sunday would be August 18th.

Jerry Block made a motion to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Elmer Baysinger. Meeting adjourned. Respectfully submitted,

Dave called the meeting to order and Pastor Barry opened with prayer and a devotional pertaining to the hymn "Great is Thy Faithfulness" written by Thomas Chisolm. He also informed the Council that Maynard Rannow's funeral went well on Monday and that he will be meeting with Pastor Bjorn to go over various items.

The secretary's minutes were approved from the July 7th meeting.

Dawn gave the treasurer's report. The beginning balance was \$53,531.85 and the ending balance is \$53,726.58.

Deb reported to Dave that the building fund checking balance is \$13,074.01 and the Vanguard account balance is \$149,191.33.

All financial reports were approved as given.

- -- Dawn also reported that the Youth lock-in was also a success. 15 kids attended (5 were regulars at Church with the rest being friends).

- -- Pastor Bjorn accepted his call on August 4th with a signed Pastoral Covenant. His start date will be August 19th with his first Sunday being the 25th. Pay will be prorated for the first month with accumulated pastor gifts being directed to him. Dave will meet with him next week to go over the order of worship, where things are kept, along with other miscellaneous items.
